MOTION: I move that a fifth bank account be opened at US Bank.

Rationale: The FDIC (Federal Deposit Insurance Corp.) limit is \$250,000 per institution. This will reduce the monthly transfer of funds to stay within the \$250,000 limit. Motion passed Board 1-20-22.

Bylaws, Shireen Mooers, Reporting

MOTION: I move to amend Standing Rules Article 4. Philanthropic Programs, Section 4.05 Name and Description. Philanthropic Programs are:. Delete entire paragraphs of (f) Bunny Baskets, (h) Helping Hearts, and (k) Teens Helping Teens. After paragraph (b) Assault Survivor Kits®., insert: (c) Assisteens Turning Compassion Into Action. The duty of this committee shall be to provide community service projects to children, teens, and adults. Rationale: One new program replaces three Assisteens Auxiliary programs. Motion passed the Board 1-20-22.

MOTION PASSED

MOTION: I move to amend Bylaws Article 12 Advisory Council, Section 12.01 Advisory Council. After "Members shall serve for a", delete "one (1) year term on a rotation basis" and insert "three (3) year term".

Rationale: Longer terms provide continuity. Rotation not currently being followed; it is difficult to keep track of when members were appointed on a rotating basis. Note: striking "on a rotation basis" is a change to NAL Guidelines (template) wording.

Motion passed the Board 1-20-22. Placed on the floor 1-24-22. Members vote 2-28-22.

MOTION: I move to amend Bylaws Article 8 Standing and Special Committees, 8.02 Elective Standing Committees, (i) Thrift Shop. Delete "and Resource Development Committee" after "The Chairman shall serve as a member of the House Operations Committee". Insert after "House Operations Committee" and Finance Committee".

Rationale: Important for Thrift Shop Chairman to serve on the Finance Committee instead of Resource Development Committee.

Motion passed the Board 1-20-22. Placed on the floor 1-24-22. Members vote 2-28-22.

MOTION: I move to amend Bylaws Article 8 Standing and Special Committees 8.03 Appointive Standing Committees, (a) Philanthropic Programs Committees, (6) Operation School Bell[®]. Delete "purchase and distribute new clothing to disadvantaged school children referred by school personnel." Replace with "provide new clothing, supplies and other needs to school children."

Rationale: Required for consistency due to chapter conforming Standing Rules 4.05 Philanthropic Program Name and Description to April 2021 NAL template recommended wording. Allows flexibility regarding items provided by OSB.

Motion passed the Board 1-20-22. Placed on the floor 1-24-22. Members vote 2-28-22.

MOTION: I move to amend Bylaws Article 8 Standing and Special Committees, Section 8.03 Appointive Standing Committees, b) Auxiliary Philanthropic Programs: Delete three paragraphs in their entirety: (3) Bunny Baskets, (4) Helping Hearts, (5) Teens Helping Teens. After entire paragraph (1) Assault Survivor Kits®, insert (2) Assisteens Turning Compassion Into Action. This committee shall be composed of the Chair and members as deemed necessary to provide community service projects to children, teens, and adults. Rationale: Streamlines Assisteens Programs; one new program replaces three terminated programs.

MOTION: I move to approve the Bylaws Chairman Job Description revised January 2022.

MOTION: I move to amend Policies of Assisteens Auxiliary Article 7 Standing and Special Committees, Section 7.03 Appointive Standing Committees: Delete three paragraphs in their entirety: (a) Bunny Baskets, (b) Helping Hearts, (c) Teens Helping Teens. Insert (a) Assisteens Turning Compassion Into Action. This committee shall be composed of the Chair and members as deemed necessary to provide community service projects to children, teens, and adults.

Rationale: Streamlines Assisteens Programs; one new program replaces three.

MOTION: I move to conform ALSLC chapter Standing Rules to NAL Guidelines April 2021:

4.05 Name and Description. Philanthropic Programs are:

(j) Operation School Bell[®]. The duty of this committee shall be to purchase and distribute provide new clothing, supplies and other needs to disadvantaged school children referred by school personnel.

6.01 Leadership Training and Treasurers' Workshop Connection Registration. Registration fees for Leadership Connection training and Treasurers' Workshop attendees shall be paid by chapter.

6.02 Proposed Expenditure. Any proposed expenditure over two thousand dollars (\$2000) requires three (3) estimates.

Rationale: Acknowledges required conforming amendments.

MOTION: I move to conform ALSLC chapter Bylaws to NAL Guidelines April 2021: **Article 10 Finance**, **10.02 Dues and Fees**. Dues for new members joining after December 1 shall be reduced by one-half (1/2) and shall include National Assistance League pro rata per capita per capita pro rata dues of twenty dollars (\$20).

Article 11 Auxiliaries, 11.04 Assisteens Auxiliary. The use of the name "Assisteens Auxiliary" shall be approved by the National Board, and it shall include the words, "an auxiliary of Assistance League of Salt Lake City." Members may be in the seventh (7th) through twelfth (12th) grades and young people in a similar age range as the specified grades.

Rationale: Acknowledges NAL Guidelines April 2021 and makes the (template) changes.
