Mentor Program Policy

The Mentor Program welcomes, educates, integrates and supports new Uplift Community Alliance members. The Mentor Program provides new members networking and social connections adding to the experience and opportunities of membership.

I. Management

- A.** A Mentor Program Chair shall be appointed by the Third Vice President, Member Services and approved by the Board.
- B.** The Mentor Program Chair shall serve on the New Member Orientation committee for the purpose of assessing how the Mentor Program committee can best integrate a new member into the Uplift Community Alliance activities.
- C.** The Mentor Program Chair shall coordinate the pairing of prospective mentors and mentees.

II. Standards

- A.** The Mentor Program Chair shall follow “Mentor Program Guidelines,” the “Mentor New Member Checklist,” and other Mentor Program procedures.
- B.** Mentees may request or decline to be paired with a mentor.
- C.** Mentors may be any voting or auxiliary member of Uplift Community Alliance League.
- D.** The mentor and mentee relationship is flexible and shall continue if deemed useful by the parties involved.
