Philanthropic Programs Policy – Uplift Associates

I. Management

- A. Uplift Associates' program Coordinators shall be appointed by the Uplift Associates Vice Chair, Philanthropic Programs.
- B. Coordinators shall present their program budget to the Vice Chair, Philanthropic Programs at their request to meet Finance Committee deadlines for the coming fiscal year.
- C. An Agreement between Uplift Community Alliance and each organization or participating agency served shall be signed by a designated organization representative.
- D. All brochures/printed material distributed to the public shall be submitted to the Marketing and Branding Committee for approval.
- E. Uplift Associates' governing body may deny a volunteer the privilege of working with any philanthropic program upon the recommendation of the Vice Chair, Philanthropic Programs if the volunteer's behavior is unlawful or inconsistent with the mission and rules of Uplift Community Alliance.

II. Standards

- A. When participating in community events, member volunteers shall be identified as members of Uplift Community Alliance.
- B. Clients shall be treated with dignity and respect, and members shall review and follow Protected Persons Behavioral and Reporting policies.
- C. Distribution shall be made by an Uplift Associates member, or a designee approved by the Uplift Associates Vice Chair or program coordinator, to organizations per agreement.
- D. All distributions shall be identified as being provided by the members of Uplift Associates, an auxiliary of Uplift Community Alliance.

III. Uplift Associates' Philanthropic Programs

Uplift Comfort Kits

- A. It is the policy of the Uplift Associates, an auxiliary of Uplift Community Alliance, to fund, manage and conduct the Uplift Comfort Kits program to serve victims of assault.
- B. Only organizations with signed agreements shall receive Uplift Comfort Kits.
- C. Only new clothing and/or supplies shall be distributed.

Baby Bundles

- A.** It is the policy of the Uplift Associates, an auxiliary of Uplift Community Alliance, to fund, manage and conduct the Baby Bundles program to serve families/babies in need.
- B.** Only hospitals or clinics with signed agreements shall receive Baby Bundles.
- C.** Only new clothing and/or supplies shall be distributed.
